



Majestic flower crowns

Create a crown using flowers, leaves and grass

You'll need:

- Thin, bendy twigs
- Long blades of grass
- Flowers
- Leaves

Flower crowns

How to...

1



Bend the twigs around your head to make a crown shape and secure them with sticky tape. This is your frame.

2



Weave the grass around the frame, using a piece at a time. Make sure the twigs are covered.

3



Add the leaves next. Push them into the grass, making sure they're secure.

4



Now thread your flowers through the grass and leaves, choosing different colours and sizes.

Ta-da!

Your crown is finished!

You might need your grown-up to help you as bending the twigs can be fiddly.
