



Collect crunchy leaves
Create your own crown

Go hunting for brightly coloured leaves. Collect as many as you can and make your very own leafy crown. Majestic!



Majestic

1 Keep your eyes peeled for leaves of all different shapes and sizes, colours and types.

2 Choose your two favourites and remove their stalks. Overlap them and use the stalks to pin them together.

3 Add one leaf at a time until there are enough joined together to go round your head.

4 Use the final stalk to join the first and last leaves together.

Or prepare your crown at home:

1 Choose a band of card that's long enough to go round your head.

2 Add a strip of double-sided tape and staple or tape the card to the right size.

3 Take your crown to the woods with you and add leaves to the double-sided tape as you go.

Now you're all set to crown yourself king or queen of the woods!
