## Deer

Deer hoof prints look like  
sausages with pointy ends.



## Pine marten

Pine martens have five toes and  
leave claw marks. The rear pad is  
shaped like a fat chevron.



## Squirrel

Squirrels leave complicated tracks  
with lots of pad and claw marks.



## Fox

Foxes have four toes, and the rear pad is  
usually the same size as the toes.



## Duck

Ducks have webbed feet to  
help them swim, and leave very  
distinctive tracks.



## Otter

Otters have five toes. You  
can sometimes see webbing  
between them.
